Thanks to our Team physician Dr. Al DeSimone and PA Paul Buchanan, our Head Athletic Trainer, Mel Camhi and the Student Athletic Trainers traveled to Weston last week to take part in a casting workshop. The students had been learning the structures of the lower arm, hand and wrist throughout the week. The students examined x-rays of injuries to this area and learned how to determine the location of the fractures. They learned how specific injuries happen and the specific casting techniques for these injuries. The students were each given the chance to experience applying and removing casts to each other. It was an excellent opportunity for them to see what happens with injuries after they happen on the field.
